Classroom Supply List (To be used by the whole class, no need to label)

- 1-Container Play-Doh
- 1-Box Tissues
- 1-Pack Paper Plates (Can be the thin, flimsy kind; will be used for crafts and light snacks)
- 1-Pack Baby Wipes
- 1-Roll Paper Towels
- 1-Pack Napkins
- 1-Can Clear, Spray-On Children's Sunscreen

Labeled Supply List (For your child only, please label clearly)

- Backpack
- Tennis shoes (To be kept at school for playtime in the gym)
- 1-2 Full changes of clothing in a zip top bag (Pants/Shorts, Shirt, Underwear, Socks; to be kept at school)
- Reusable water bottle
- ****Full Day Children Only****
 - Lunch: If not buying school lunch, please send your child's lunch in a lunchbox with an ice pack. We do not have enough refrigerator space in the classroom to store lunches. Please send ready to eat foods as we will not be able to microwave lunches. Bento Box style containers (one container with several small compartments) are great for school!
 - Nap time: Fitted crib sheet and a small blanket. Optional-one small stuffy/lovey and a small pillow. Please keep in mind that we have limited storage space and avoid large pillows/blankets/stuffed animals. Nap items will be kept at school and sent home regularly to be laundered.
